Flying Flags in the UK



While local councils are demanding the removal of flags, in many cases they have no right to. There is a government document at <a href="https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/flying-flags-a-plain-english-guide/flying-flags-a-plain-english-guide/flying-flags-a-plain-english-guide/flying-flags-a-plain-english-guide/flying-flags-a-plain-english-guide which clearly grants permission to fly flags of following a reasonable criteria.

The basics:

•Flag Size:

- •Flags on a projecting flagpole cannot exceed 2 square meters.
- •There are no size restrictions on flags flown from a vertical flagpole on a roof or within the grounds of a building.

•Pole Types:

- •Vertical flagpole on the roof of a building.
- •Projecting flagpole from any part of a building other than the roof.
- •Flagpole within the grounds of a building.

•Pole Length:

- •A flagpole within the grounds of a building may not exceed 4.6 meters above ground level.
- •There are no maximum length limits mentioned for vertical flagpoles on a roof or for projecting flagpoles.

•Character/Symbol Height (in controlled areas):

- •Characters on a flag flown from a vertical flagpole on a roof can be no taller than 0.75 meters (or 0.3 meters in an area of special control).
- •There are no restrictions on the size of characters on flags flown from a projecting flagpole.
